## Reflection on Today's Gospel by Father Stephen

Following the close parallel that St Luke establishes between Jesus and John the Baptist in his infancy narrative, the liturgy also celebrates two births, the birth of the Messiah at the winter solstice and the birth of the Precursor at the summer solstice. John is clearly important.

When Elizabeth gives birth relatives and neighbours share her joy and expect Zechariah and Elizabeth to call their son after his father. But they call him John, as commanded by the angel of the Lord, a name which means 'God's gracious gift.' It is already the good news and Zechariah gives thanks to God for it. John has a strange destiny. On the one hand a saintly intolerance of the things of this earth. "He shall drink neither wine, nor any strong drink." Yet also an intense spiritual joy, shown when he leaps in his mother's womb and when as an adult he points out the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. John preaches a baptism of repentance to bring people back to God and put their relationships in order,



foreshadowing the reconciliation Christ will achieve. He turns hearts towards Jesus and then goes quietly away.


Congratulations to all the children from our LPA who were confirmed on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> June at Our Lady and St John's Church.
